### 3. Tax-free and taxable state benefits

## State benefits that are taxable

The most common benefits that you pay Income Tax on are:

- the State Pension
- · Jobseeker's Allowance
- Carer's Allowance
- Employment and Support Allowance (contribution based)
- Incapacity Benefit (from the 29th week you get it)
- Bereavement Allowance
- pensions paid by the Industrial Death Benefit scheme
- Widowed Parent's Allowance
- · Widow's pension

#### Tax-free state benefits

The most common state benefits you don't have to pay Income Tax on are:

- · Housing Benefit
- · Employment and Support Allowance (income related)
- Income Support though you may have to pay tax on Income Support if you're involved in a strike
- Working Tax Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Disability Living Allowance
- Child Benefit (income based use the Child Benefit tax calculator (https://www.gov.uk/child-benefit-tax-calculator) to see if you'll have to pay tax)
- Guardian's Allowance
- Attendance Allowance
- · Pension Credit
- Winter Fuel Payments and Christmas Bonus
- free TV licence for over-75s
